Your Right to Seek Board and Judicial Review: You have a right to appeal this full or partial denial to the YCUA Director or to commence an action in the Washtenaw County Circuit Court under Section 10 of the FOIA to compel release of the requested records if you believe they have been wrongfully withheld from disclosure. An appeal to the YCUA Director must state the word "appeal" and must identify the reason(s) for reversal of the denial. If the court determines that YCUA has violated the FOIA by failing to disclose all or part of a record, you have a right to receive from the court a court order directing YCUA to pay your reasonable attorney fees and money damages under Section 10 of the FOIA.
