RAMBLING PUMP STATION EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT YPSILANTI COMMUNITY UTILITIES AUTHORITY Ypsilanti, Michigan

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Rambling Pump Station will be received by Ypsilanti Community Utilities Authority (YCUA), in the Engineering Department at the YCUA offices at 2777 State Road, Ypsilanti Michigan 48198 until 1:00 pm local time on October 7, 2020 at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Project consists of replacement of the two (2) submersible centrifugal pumps, piping and guide rails inside the wet well, as well as the replacement of the pump control panel utilizing float controls. Sewage bypass pumping is required during equipment replacement. Additionally, an onsite natural gas emergency power generator shall be furnished and installed.

Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than those listed herein. Bidders should direct correspondence to the Engineer.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bid security in the form of a bid bond for a sum no less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid will be required with each Bid. Bids shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes plainly marked with the project name and the name of the bidder.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of the Bids. YCUA reserves and has the right, in YCUA's sole discretion: to reject or accept any bid/proposal, including without limitation, a non-conforming, non-responsive, unbalanced, incomplete or conditional bid/proposal; to waive any failure to comply with or fully satisfy the requirements of bid specifications or the specifications of a request for proposal; to extend the time for filing a bid or proposal; to reject the bid/proposal of any bidder/proposer if YCUA believes it would not be in the best interest of the project or YCUA to make an award to that bidder/proposer; to reject the bid or proposal of any bidder/proposer whom YCUA finds, after reasonable inquiry, to be non-responsive; to waive all informalities not including price, time or changes in the work; or, to negotiate contract terms with the apparent successful bidder/proposer.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 1:00 P.M. local time on September 22, 2020 at the YCUA Rambling Pump Station (1249 Rambling Road, Ypsilanti, Michigan, 48198). Bids from those who fail to attend will be considered a non-responsive bid.
