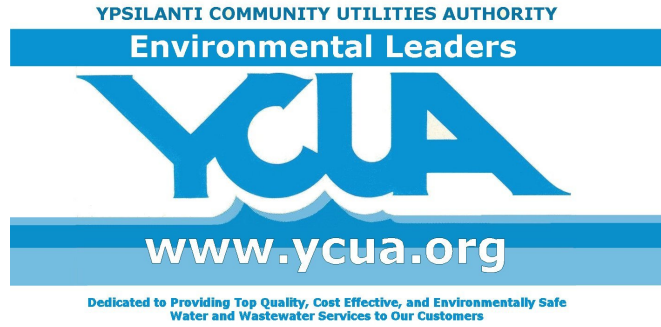

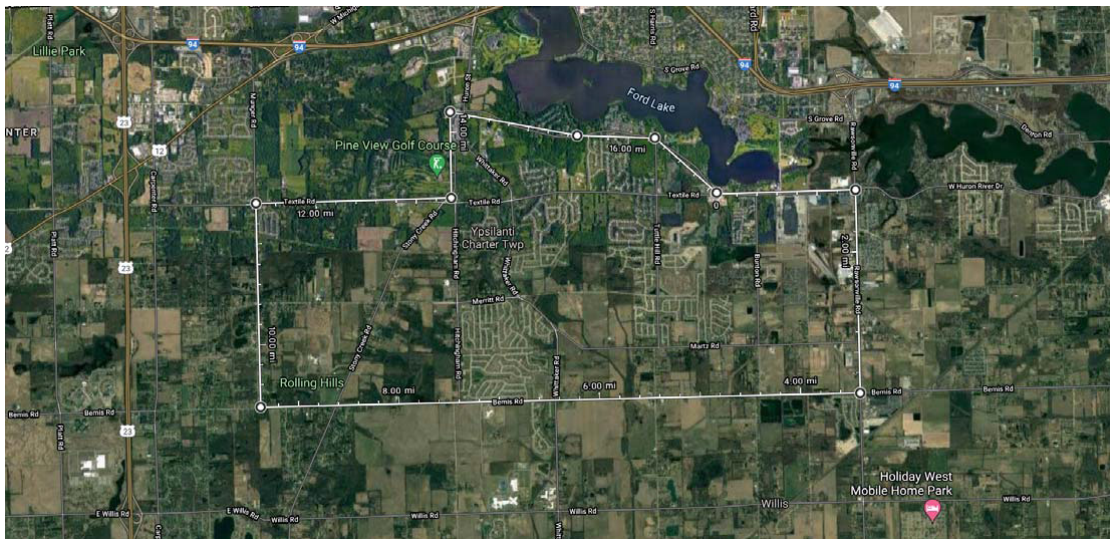

## YCUA Conducting Hydrant Painting Program This Summer

YCUA is currently conducting a hydrant painting program to maintain the quality and longevity of its fire hydrants. Being able to identify these hydrants at a moment's notice is extremely important. The number of hydrants and areas to be done will be dependent on the weather.

Hydrants that will be painted this summer are in the southwest portion of Ypsilanti Township: south of I-94, east of Munger, and north of Bemis Road to Rawsonville Road.

Conventional water system hydrant painting consists of cleaning, weed trimming if needed, and then painting each hydrant in a specific neighborhood. During this process, customers might notice some slight overspray on the grass, however we do protect the grass the best that we can.

YCUA employees that are performing the task of painting hydrants will be in a well-lit YCUA truck with safety lights and the employees will have approved MIOSHA protective traffic safety vests on at all times outside of the truck.
