As part of the ongoing dedication to provide top quality, cost effective, and environmentally safe water and wastewater services to our customers, YCUA continues to make improvements to the existing State Street wastewater pump station and discharge force main. The pump station is located on the north side of State Street between Glengrove Avenue and Nash Avenue. The discharge force main heads east on State Street to McCartney Avenue, then north on McCartney Avenue before crossing Wiard Road to the intersection of Wildwood Avenue and Watson Street.

The project was designed for YCUA by OHM Advisors, Inc. (OHM), of Livonia, Michigan. On behalf of YCUA, OHM will also be administering the construction contract and providing full-time, on-site observation of the work by Verdeterre Contracting, Inc., of Belleville, Michigan.

The first phase of the work, involving installation of the new discharge force main following the route described above, is underway and is anticipated to be complete before the end of this month. Once the pipe installation is complete, work on the project will stop as equipment is manufactured for the improvements at the pump station. It is anticipated that all equipment necessary for those improvements will be delivered and ready for installation approximately 5 months from now.

Notification will be provided closer to the start of work at the pump station site as equipment deliveries are confirmed. As always, the patience and understanding of all those affected by the construction of these important upgrades is appreciated.
